Q.1) Why are teeth important to us?

Ans.:- Teeth give Shape to face help to chew food and to speak properly.

Q.2) What are milk teeth? How many teeth are there in a temporary set of teeth?

Ans.:- Milk teeth are the temporary set of teeth. There are 20 teeth in a temporary set of teeth.

- Q.3) What kind of food should you eat to keep your teeth and gums healthy? Ans.:- Proper cleaning and good food habits help in keeping the teeth healthy.
- Q.4) What are the different types of teeth? Describe their functions? Ans.:- There are four different kinds of teeth-Incisors, Canines, Premolars and Molars.
- (i) Incisors These are flat, thin teeth help in biting or cutting the food.
- (ii) Canines They are sharp and pointed
- (iii) Premolars:-These are broad flat and thick help in crushing the food.
- (iv) Molars :- These are used in grinding the food.

Q.5) How do cavities form in teeth?

Ans.:- Cavities are caused due to tooth decay. Cavities develop due to action of bacteria on teeth.
