Answer the following questions:-

Q.1) Why are teeth important to us?

Ans.:- Teeth give Shape to face help to chew food and to speak properly.

Q.2) What are milk teeth ? How many teeth are there in a temporary set of teeth?

Ans.:- Milk teeth are the temporary set of teeth. There are 20 teeth in a temporary set of teeth.

Q.3) What kind of food should you eat to keep your teeth and gums healthy?

Ans.:- Proper cleaning and good food habits help in keeping the teeth healthy.

Q.4) What are the different types of teeth? Describe their functions ?

Ans.:- There are four different kinds of teeth-

Incisors, Canines, Premolars and Molars.

(i) Incisors - These are flat, thin teeth help in biting or cutting the food.

(ii) Canines - They are sharp and pointed

(iii) Premolars:-These are broad flat and thick help in crushing the food.

(iv) Molars :- These are used in grinding the food.

Q.5) How do cavities form in teeth ?

Ans.:- Cavities are caused due to tooth decay. Cavities develop due to action of bacteria on teeth.

Q.6) What are microbes? Name any two microbes and diseases caused by them.

Ans.:-Microbes are very tiny living things, which can be seen, only under a microscope.

Bacteria - They cause diseases such as typhoid, pneumonia and tuberculosis

Virus - These cause diseases like Common cold, chicken pox, small pox etc.
