- 1. Adjective of Quality describe the quality of people or things. They answer the question 'What kind?'. For example
 - She is an old woman.
 - It is a hot drink.
 - Raj is a naughty boy.
- Adjective of Quantity describe the quantity of noun. They answer the question 'How much?'. For example
 - Give me some water to drink.
 - I have many friends.
- 3. Adjective of Number tells us about the number of a noun. They answer the question 'How many?'. For example
 - There are forty students in my class.
 - I have three pencils.
