TOPIC: ADJECTIVES

Types of Adjectives

1. **Adjective of Quality** describe the quality of people or things. They answer the question 'What kind?'. For example
 - She is an **old** woman.
 - It is a **hot** drink.
 - Raj is a **naughty** boy.
2. **Adjective of Quantity** describe the quantity of noun. They answer the question 'How much?'. For example
 - Give me **some** water to drink.
 - I have **many** friends.
3. **Adjective of Number** tells us about the number of a noun. They answer the question 'How many?'. For example
 - There are **forty** students in my class.
 - I have **three** pencils.
