## Topic – Genders

Types of genders

- ❖ Words or nouns used for male (persons or animal) are called Masculine Gender. For example – boy, son, husband
- ❖ Words or nouns used for female (persons or animals) are feminine Gender. For example – mother, sister, girl, daughter
- ❖ Words or nouns used for either male or female (persons or animals) are called Common Gender. For example – teacher, parents
- ❖ Words or nouns which have no life in them are called Neuter Gender. They are neither male nor female. For example – bed, garden
