Topic: Singular / Plural Nouns

A noun is a person, place, thing or animal.

Plural noun talks about more than one person, place, thing or animal.

Rules: for making noun plural:

1. For most of the nouns, we add 's' at the end

Ex. Dog → dogs, cat → cats

2. Some nouns end in -s, -ss, -x, -ch, -sh and -o. We add 'es' to these nouns

Ex. Box → boxes, glass → glasses, dish → dishes, match → matches

3. Some Nouns end in '-y'. To make them plural, we change y to -ies.

Ex. Baby → babies, City → cities

4. Some Nouns end in '-f' or '-fe'. To make them plural, we change -f to -ves.

Ex. Knife → knives, Leaf → leaves

5. There are also some special nouns. There is no rule to change them to plural nouns

Ex. Tooth → teeth Man → Men Child → Children
 Foot → feet Woman → Women Fish → Fish
 Goose → Geese Mouse → mice Sheep → Sheep
