Q1. Identify these famous landmarks? Read the given clues, and write your answers.

1.) It is the oldest and the only one of seven wonders of the ancient world to exist today. Built on the banks of the river Nile, they are located in Al-Jīzah (Giza), in modern Egypt.



2) Located in Rio de Janeiro, it is a giant statue of Jesus Christ. The construction of the statue began in 1926 and was completed five years later in 1931.

3) This was an ancient Arab city, the ruins of which are now located in Jordan. Many of the buildings here have been directly carved in the rocky cliffs.



4) This is one of the largest man-made structures on earth. The ancient Chinese built it to protect themselves from outside attacks.

5) This sandstone palace is in Jaipur. It has more than 900 windows called *jharokhas*.



6) This is in New York. It was given by the people of France to the people of the United States, to celebrate the friendship between the two countries.

7. It is named after its designer and engineer, Gustave Eiffel.
