Ques/Answers

Q1) According to Humpty Dumpty, what did his name mean?

Ans. According to Humpty Dumpty his name meant a shape of his body and a good handsome shape.

Q2) What had the King promised to Humpty Dumpty?

Ans. The King had promised that he will send all his horses and all his men to put him together if he ever falls.

Q3) What did Alice think about un-birthday presents? Why did Humpty Dumpty disagree with her?

Q4) Answer with reference to the context.

Read the following sentence and answer the following questions that follow.

i) Who said this and to whom?

Ans. Alice said this to Humpty Dumpty.

ii) Why would he be safer on the ground?

Ans. He was sitting on the top of a high, narrow wall. So, he would be safer on the ground.
