Answer 1 Emancipation Proclamation was expected to be significant as it was a light of hope to millions of Negro slaves to be freed from chains of discrimination and racial injustice. No, the conditions had not changed hundred years later. The Negroes were still being discriminated.

Answer2 The promissory note was significant as it meant to free Negroes in America of slavery . It also promised them justice and equality. What we infer from Martin Luther King's speech is that the Negroes in America were not granted their rights.

Answer 3 He had a dream that all men are treated equally in America. He also dreamt that the sons of former slaves and the sons of former slave- owners consider themselves as brothers. He had a dream that one day his children would live in a nation where they would be judged on the basis of their character and not the colour of skin.

Answer4 The speaker said so because he did not want his people to follow the path of immorality in their pursuit of justice. Yes, it was the right kind of guidance for the people as one must follow the correct path towards justice.

Abstract nouns refer to qualities, feelings, or ideas. For example,

- beauty
- wisdom
- health

All the nouns that we can count are called **countable nouns**. For example,

- tree
- bottle
- building

All the nouns that cannot be counted are called **uncountable nouns**. For example,

- cheese
- water
- salt
