1) How are forests important to us?

Ans.1:- The forests are important to us in the following ways:-

- 1) They give us pure air, wood, fruits, gum and medicinal herbs.

- 3) They are home to animals.
- 4) They prevent soil erosion.

2) What is the difference between Evergreen and deciduous trees?

Ans.2:- **Evergreen Trees:-**

- 1) The Evergreen trees do not shed their leaves. They remain green throughout the year. Ex.:- Ebony, Mahogany, Rosewood.
- 2) They are also called “Tropical Rainforests”.

**Deciduous Trees:-**

- 1) The Deciduous trees shed their leaves in the dry season.  
Ex.-Teak, Sal, Sandalwood
- 2) They are also called “ Monsoon Forests.”
