LITERACY CAMPAIGN



The following activities were organized:-




Many Interactors taught their grandparents how to use Android Phones. Several people of all age groups benefited through this project.

THALASSEMIA AWARENESS PROGRAM BY RTN. DR. TEJINDER SINGH

GTB 3rd Centenarian believed in expanding the knowledge and awareness about diseases and their prolonged.



Thus our Interact Club in association with Rotary Club of Delhi Safdarjung organised an Awareness Program about the deadly disease - Thalassemia on 16th September at 11:30 am for the students of class XI-XII. It was conducted by the recognised speaker and The Face of Thalassemia, Rtn. Dr. Tejinder Singh ji, who explained the causes, symptoms and control of this disease with the help of a video which was followed by an Interactive Quiz.

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Thalassemia is an inherited blood disorder characterized by weakness, paleness and slow growth.

Later she convinced that the screening for this is must and urged all to spread the information about Thalassemia to at least ten people.

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Our Guest of Honour was Rtn. Rakesh Kumar, Past District Interact Advisor who also in his address made them aware of seriousness and sensitivity with which Thalassemia needs to be dealt with.

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




In the end, all took pledge- "Let's dive deeper into this topic and take care of our physical health."

She urged the Interactors to become Thalassemia Awareness Ambassadors and spread the message of 'Prevention of Thalassemia' to many more students.










ENVIRONMENT DAY
