The insightful and memorable session culminated with the Vote of Thanks proposed by Mrs. Shilpi Ahuja (Teacher In-charge Interact Club).

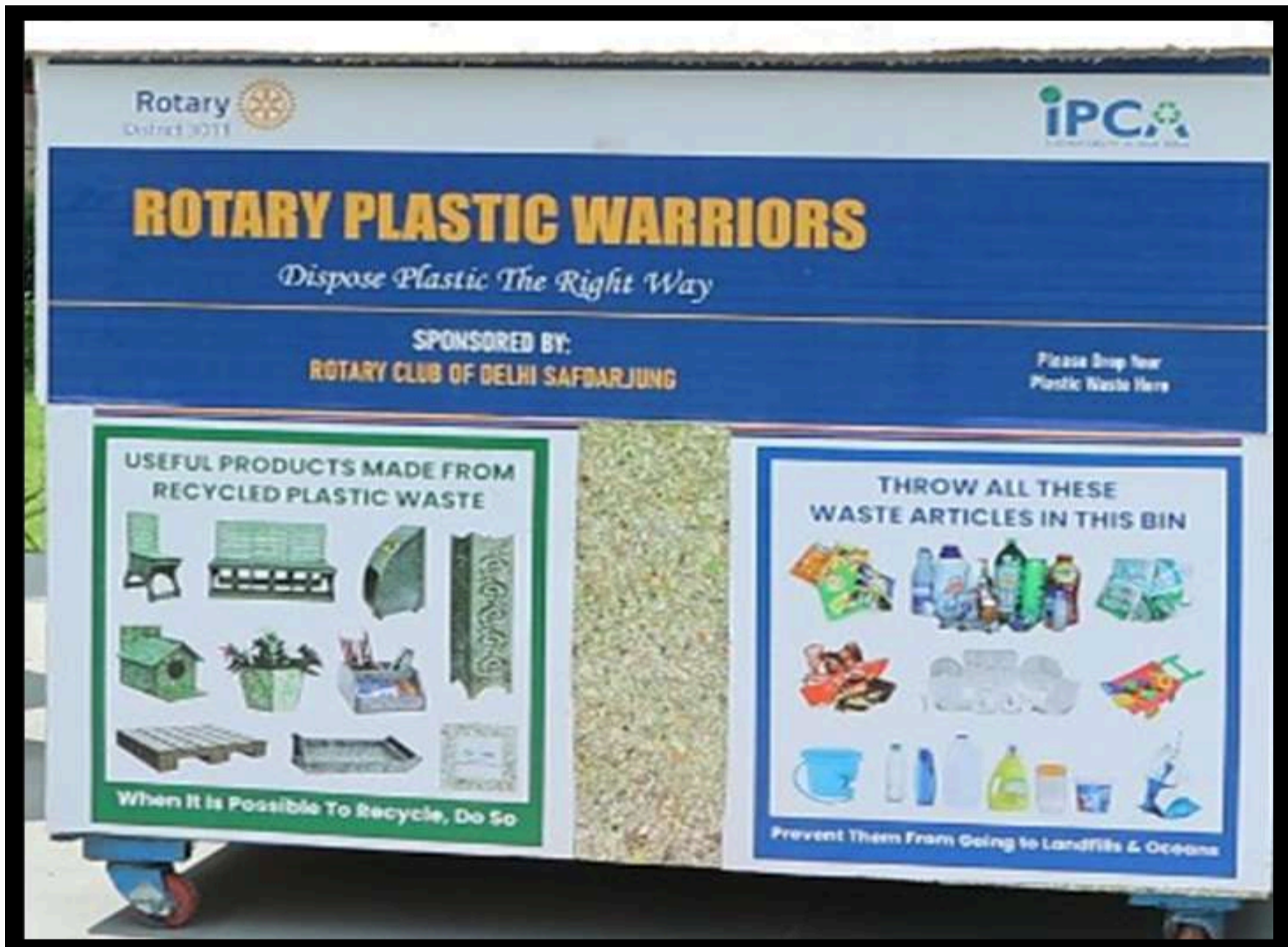

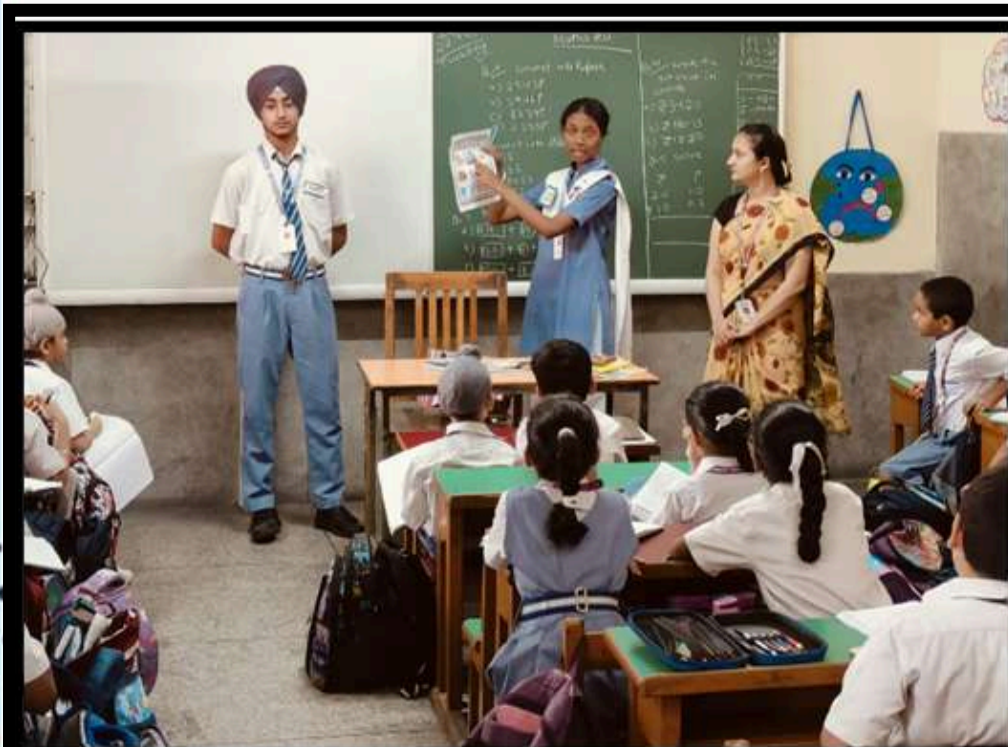

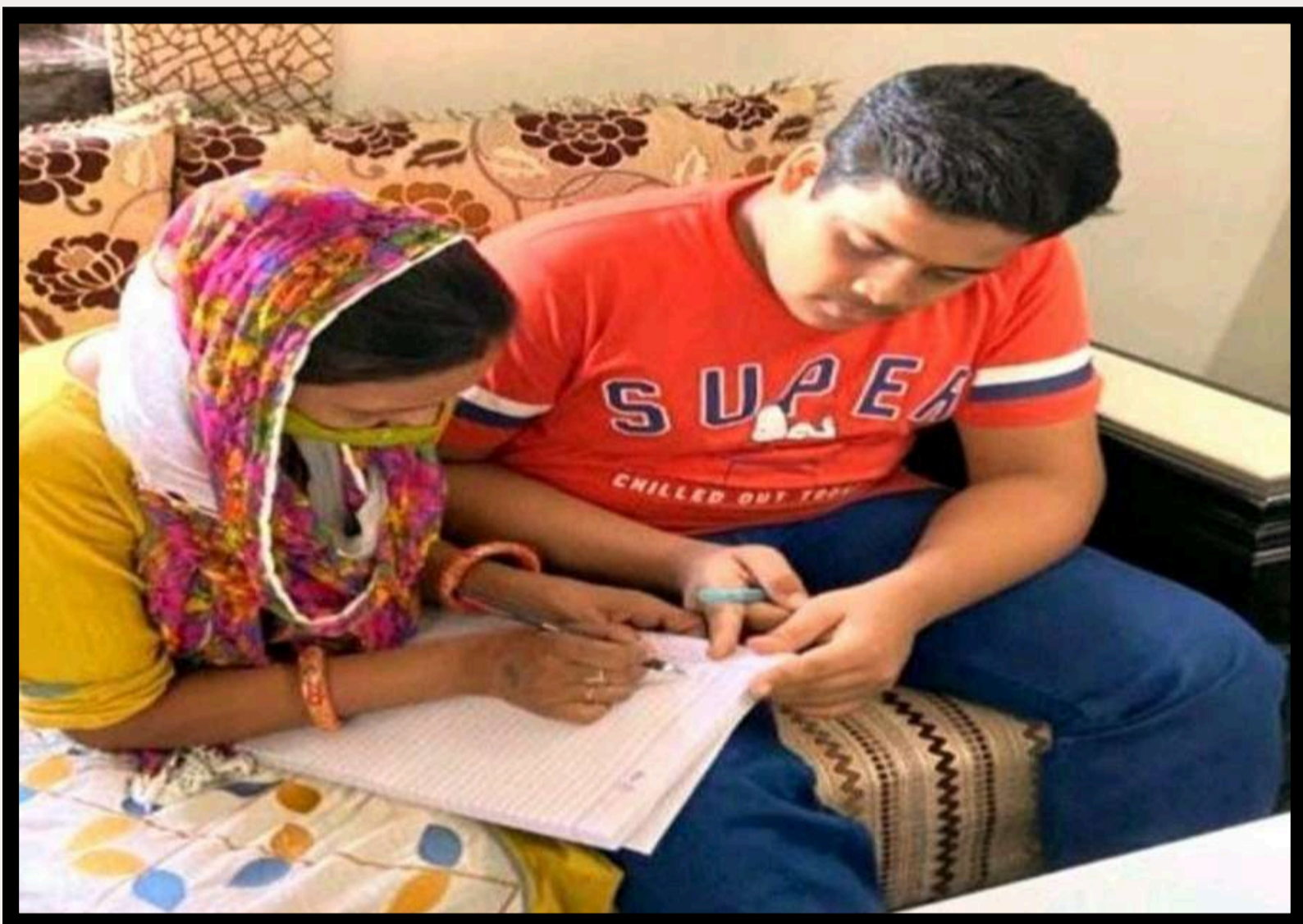

Many Interactors taught their grandparents how to use Android Phones.

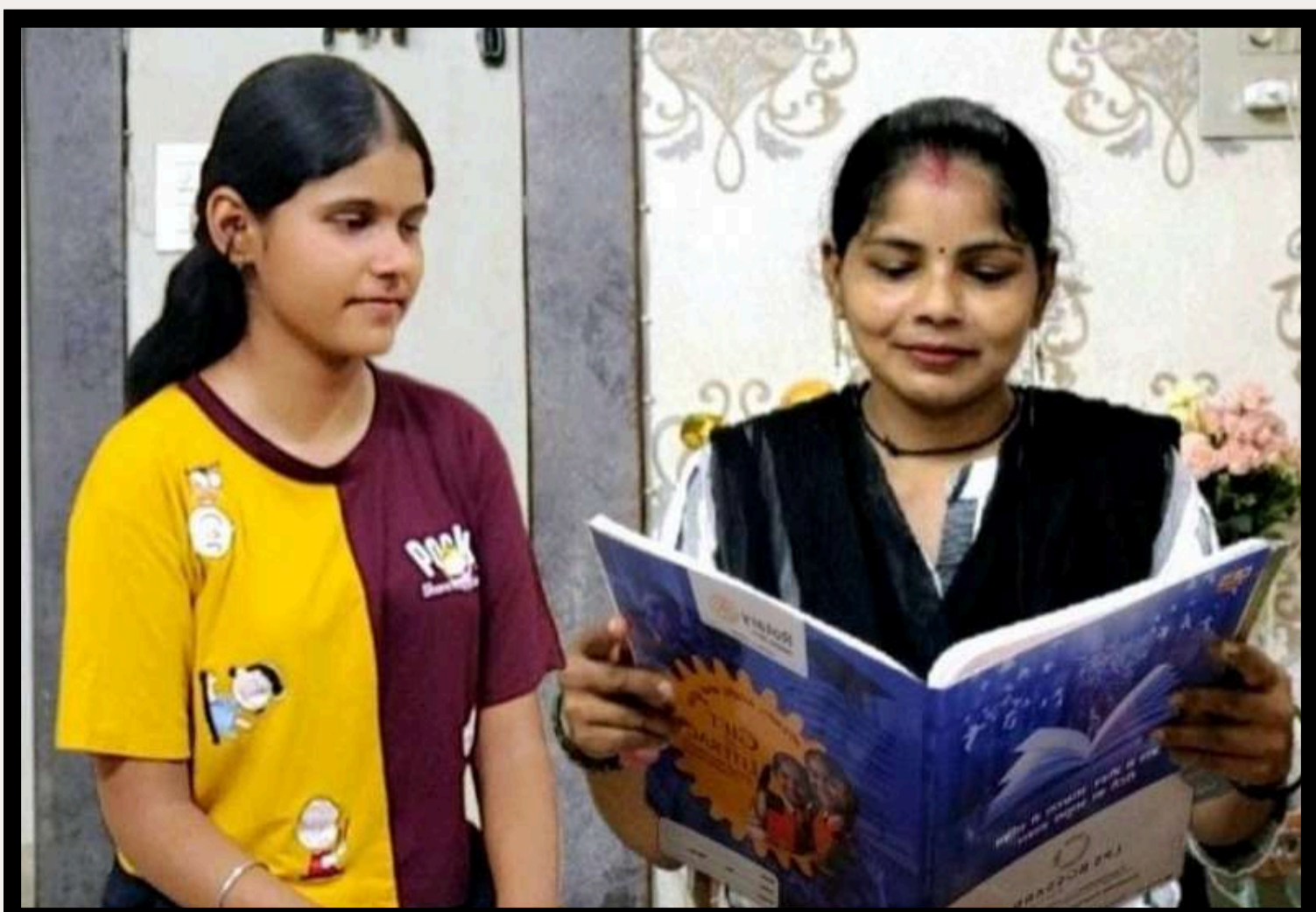




The interactors also distributed Literacy Kits to the needy ones provided by Rotary Club.

She Inspired the students by giving example of her own bravery and courage which she maintained during the Kargil War.

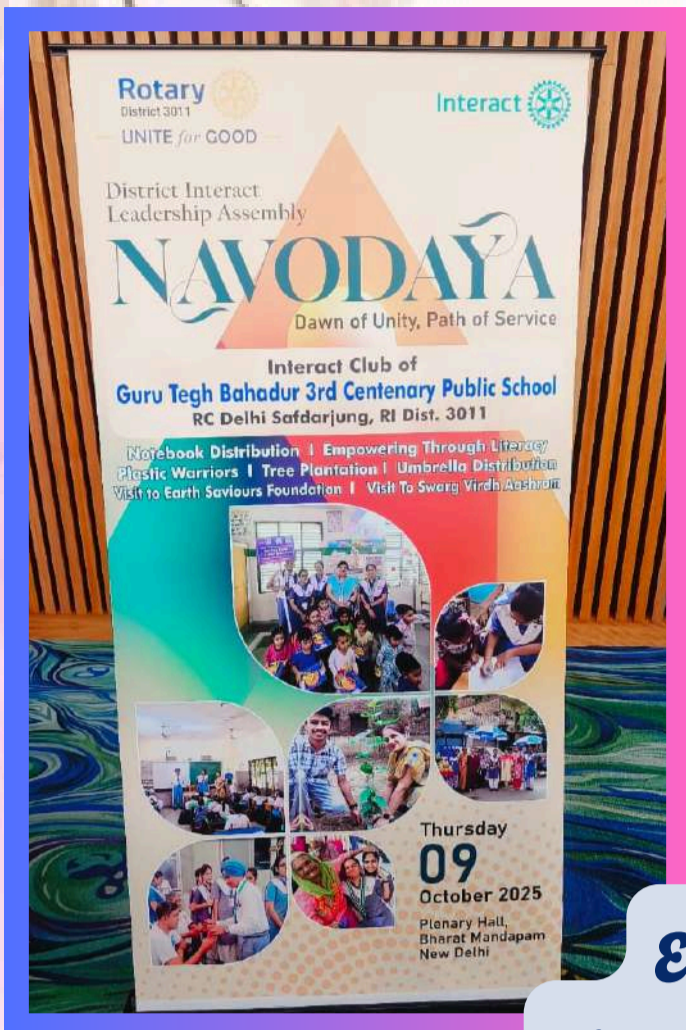
She also discussed about the importance of time management.

The program concluded with a captivating Dance Drama presented by more than 400 students from different Schools.



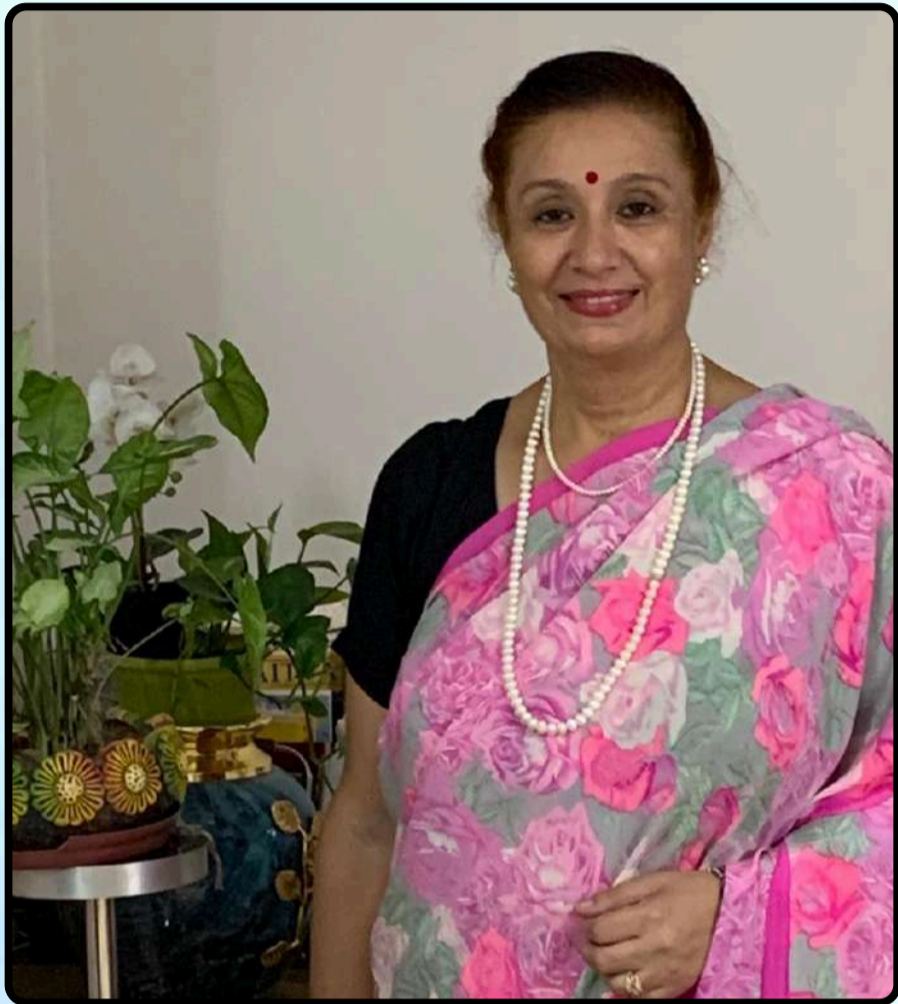
Every Interact club was gifted a Standee showcasing their Innovative Interact Projects.

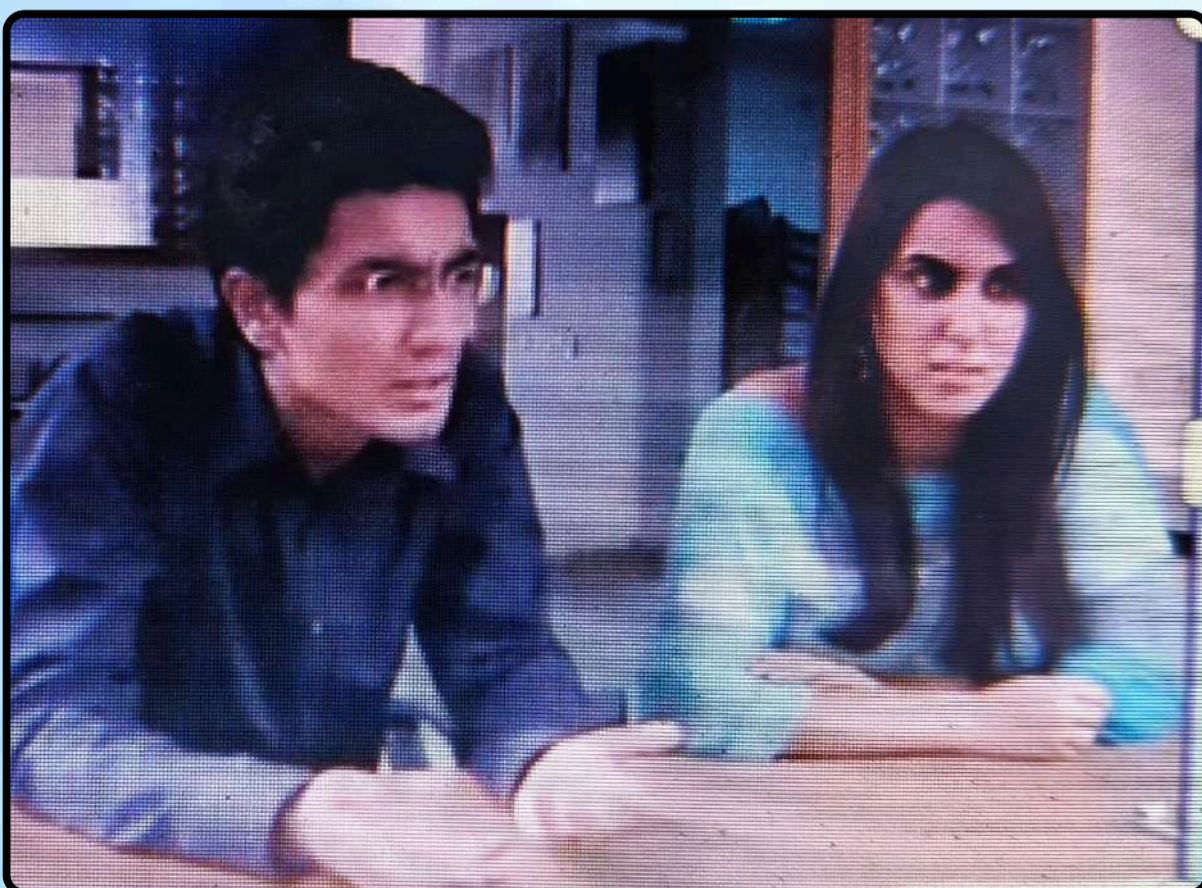

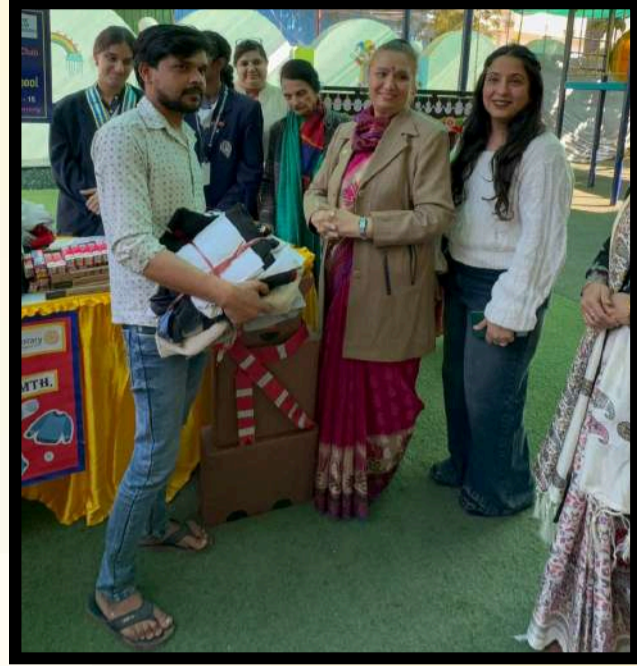
Instilling the Values of Caring & Sharing
