## Chapter-13(Our Water Resources-II)

## (I) Define the following Terms:-

1) Fresh Water:- Water that is not salty.

2) Persian Wheel:- A wheel with buckets attached to it. As the wheel is turned by bullocks, buffaloes or camels, the buckets lift water.

3) Tubewell:- A tube is sunk in the hole and water is brought up using an electric pump. Such a well is called a tubewell.

4) Dam:- A dam is a very strong wall built across a river to block the flow of water.

5) Groundwater:-Rainwater that seeps into the ground and collects there is called groundwater.

6) Reservoir:- A lake created behind a dam is called a reservoir.

7) Canals:- Channels which carry water from a river to the fields are called canals.

8) Hydroelectricity:-Electricity generated from falling water is called hydroelectricity.
