❖ Punctuation marks tell us where to pause, where to stop and how to start a sentence. It helps us to understand the meaning of a sentence clearly.

1. The use of capital letters:

- A new sentence begins with a capital letter.
- Name of people, places etc. begin with a capital letter.
- Days of week and months of the year begin with a capital letter.
- Names of mountains, rivers, oceans etc. begin with a capital letter.
- "I" is always written capital.

2. The use of Full stop (.)

A sentence ends with a full stop (.).

3. The use of Question Mark (?)

Sentences that ask for information end with a question mark (?).

4. The use of Exclamation Mark (!).

We use exclamation mark (!) to express strong emotions.

5. The use of Comma (,)

- It is used within a sentence to separate a list of items.
- We do not use the comma (,) before the last item or name in a list.
 We use "and" instead.
